

What does our 30 hour offer look like at Preston Grange Primary?

Our 30 hour offer consists of:

15 hours of morning Nursery 8:55am to 11:55am Monday to Friday. **This is our universal Nursery offer and we ask all children to attend all sessions.**

15 hours of additional afternoon Nursery Provision (if eligible)
11.45am to 3:25pm Monday to Thursday.

It is our expectation that families wishing to access our 30 hour provision, commit to their child attending each afternoon session (Monday to Thursday) This is for funding and staffing reasons.

Children accessing the 30 hour provision enjoy a packed lunch from home.

What is 30 hours provision and who is it for?

Preston Grange Primary School are happy to offer 30 hours of Nursery provision for eligible families.

Your eligibility depends on:

- if you are working
- your income (and your partner's income, if you have one)
- your child's age and circumstances
- your immigration status

Eligible parents wishing to take up the 30 hour offer must obtain a code from this website:

www.gov.uk/apply-30-hours-free-childcare which must be passed on to the school office along with your NI (National Insurance) number in order for it to be validated. A cut off date will be given to ensure your funding is in place for the next term. Failure to provide this information by the given date will delay your child's access to the provision.

There is a condition that this code is renewed every three months for your eligibility to continue.
