# SATs meetings for parents of Year 2 and Year 6 children

Further to the information on the previous newsletter, we will be holding two SATs meetings on Monday  $22^{nd}$  February immediately after school at 3.35pm. The Year 2 meeting will be held in the Year 2 classroom, and the Year 6 meeting will take place in the Year 6 classroom. At this meeting, we will explain the changes to the SATs for both year groups this year, and also explain how you may best support your children at home and how we are preparing the children in school for the assessments. We hope as many of you as possible are able to attend.

#### **Ice Packs**

We have in school a supply of ice packs, which are dark blue in colour. We give these to the children if necessary when they have been first aided after a bump. We would be grateful if parents could check at home and see if any children have accidentally brought one home from school, as before Christmas we had over 20 in school. There are now only 7 in the medical fridge, and we have searched high and low for them in school. If you do find an ice pack at home, we would be grateful if you would send them into the school office. Thank you.

## Update on Nursery

As you will be aware, we are opening a teacher led school based Nursery in September this year. We are now completely full for 2016-17, as all places have been allocated, and we even have a reserve list. We are however still taking application forms for September 2017, January 2017, September 2018, January 2018 and beyond. If you know anyone in our catchment area, please let them know that we are still taking applications.

We are in the process of going to advert for the new 0.5 Nursery teacher post, and hope to appoint the teacher at the end of February, although they won't start until September.

There are some alterations to do internally in order to get ready for the movement of classes to make room for Nursery in September. These are all planned and work starts this week to convert the internal quad into an outdoor space for the new Year 1 classroom (current ICT suite.)
