Key stage 2 SATs

The dates for Key Stage 2 SATs have already been shared with parents, but we have been pleasantly surprised by some new information that has been released this week. Traditionally, the children have always sat the Reading paper on the Monday of SATs week. Since SATs started, there has never been any deviation from this order.

The Reading paper is a heavy paper, and we have always felt that to change the order of the tests would be good for the children. This year, they have finally rearranged the order of SATs week and the Reading paper is now on day 2, with the children starting on the Monday with Spelling & Grammar tests. We feel that this will benefit the children, in that they will be more confident and feel 'warmed up' to the test situation by the time they sit the Reading paper on the Tuesday.
