



PHOTOGRAPH AND VIDEO CONSENT FORM

In line with current data protection and GDPR rules (2018). We need to ensure that the school is meeting the requirements, we need to re-seek your consent to take and use photographs and videos of your child.

At PGPS we take all matters relating to child safety very seriously. This includes the use of images of pupils. Photographs and videos can be motivating for the pupils involved, provide a good opportunity to promote the work of the school and are invaluable tools for professional training. However, schools have a duty of care towards pupils, which means that pupils must remain unidentifiable, reducing the risk of possible inappropriate contact.

PGPS follows these rules:

- Where media can be accessed externally, for example the school website, school newsletters and the school's social media pages:
 - we will not use a photograph with full name and class information alongside
- Where showcasing examples of pupils work with accompanying photographs around the school, we will use only a child's first name.
- Staff take photographs inline with the acceptable use and image use policies. Staff will not take photographs of children on personal devices.

We need your consent to take photographs, films and other digital images of your children and to use them in the sorts of ways described above. If you are not happy for us to do this, we will accommodate your preferences.
